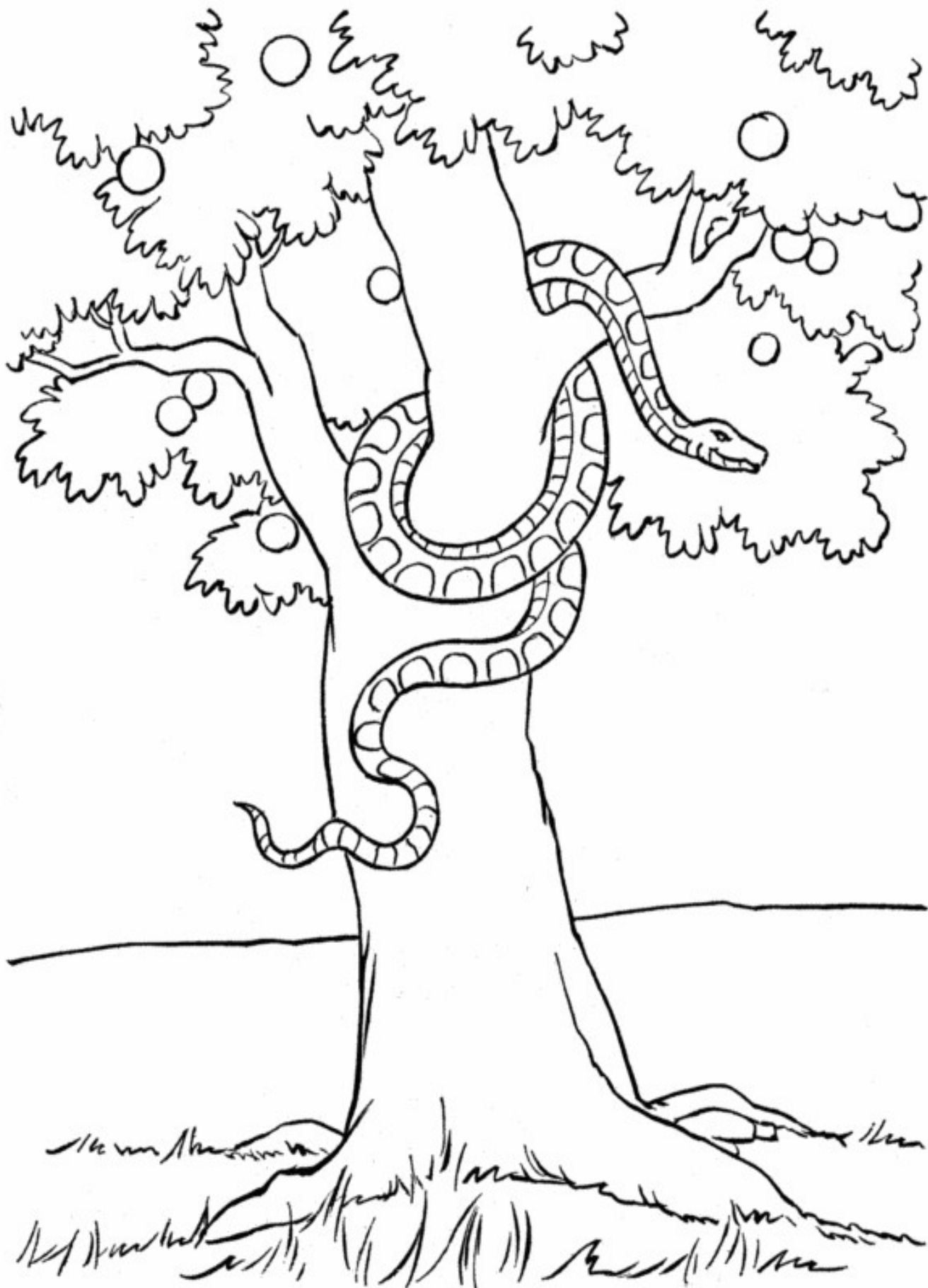
Let's Pray:
